MJW Regional and State Tournament Rules

1. Entry fee is \$25.00.
2. A wrestler's age group classification is determined by the year they were born.
3. Folk style wrestling, NFHS rules will govern all matches, except as modified by MDJW.
4. All bouts 1-1-1 except 11&12, and 13&14 will wrestle 1 ½ -1 ½, 1 ½, double eliminations, overtime 1, 30/30, 30 if needed.

5. Headgear are required, singlets are required.
6. Participants must weigh in at the weight class they have entered. Weigh-in will be required only once.
7. A wrestler cannot wrestle outside his/her age group, and may enter in one weight class only.
8. Weight classes with less than 3 wrestlers may be combined at the discretion of the Tournament Director; award and advancement will be given based on entry division and weight.
9. Matches against team members will be avoided in the first round if possible..
10. The source of rules governing this tournament will be the NFHS Rule Book, the Maryland Junior Wrestling Rules Booklet, and the Region Rules that apply to the operation of the qualifying tournament.
11. Only fulltime residents of Maryland may enter the Maryland Junior Wrestling Regional tournaments.
12. Skin form and doctor's note required in applicable. (see website) The hair rule for the Maryland Junior Wrestling tournaments will be enforced as defined in the NFHS Rules Book.
13. Counties eligible in Region VI: Howard & Anne Arundel County. Non-regional entrants must submit transfer request. (see website)
14. Regional Director's decision is final.

State Tournament Advancement Information

1. MDJW State Championship Tournament on Saturday & Sunday, February 27-28th, 2010, at the Cole Field House, College Park, MD
2. Top 2 place winners per weight class/age group (8U, 10U, 12U, 14U) are qualifiers. Determined by true 2nd if necessary.
3. An advancement registration fee of \$25 will be collected on February 7th before the wrestler departs from the tournament. If advancements are not desired, next placement will be offered advancement (3rd place then 4th place).
4. USA Wrestling Card REQUIRED for State Tournament. Purchase on-line @: <http://www.themat.com>
5. Copy of birth certificate will be required of all Region VI qualifiers advancing to the State Championship Tournament.
